Various components like nuts, bolts, gears etc. are repaired or replaced as considered necessary.

When the overhaul has been accomplished, the engine is rebuilt manually. After being put back together, a series of tests are applied to the running equipment so as to check all of the components and make certain there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the needed adjustments are made.
